Total Current Positive Healthcare Client Enrollment is 1,541 clients, with Roster Numbers broken down as follows:

867 enrollees in PHC California, a Medi-Cal (Medicaid) managed care plan for people living with AIDS in Los Angeles County.

617 enrollees in PHP (HMO SNP) Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug health plan specifically for Medicare beneficiaries who are living with AIDS and reside in Los Angeles County.

AHF Dental currently operated two full service dental clinics for people living with HIV/AIDS in the US. In Los Angeles, the Downtown AHF Dental Clinic serves a census of 1,239 patients. In South Florida, the AHF Dental Clinic in Ft. Lauderdale currently serves a census of 288 patients.

Broward House Founded in 1988 in Ft Lauderdale to provide housing to those living with HIV or AIDS, housing remains a core component of Broward House's services. The agency expanded its services to include prevention, education, and related services in order to reduce the number of people becoming infected with HIV, increase the number of individuals living with HIV receiving care, and reduce stigma. Impulse

Impulse United is a volunteer group of active individuals in collaboration with AHF, whose purpose is to promote sexual & lifestyle wellness using modern social approaches.

Impulse is now the largest HIV/Wellness group in the world, comprised entirely of volunteers, and, in the last 12 months, organized over 500 events and over 20 campaigns. Impulse is made up of over 300 volunteers in 25 cities.

BLACC – Black Leadership AIDS Crisis Coalition

BLACC was developed to create a coalition of Black-American cultural influencers and health advocates, that through the use of innovative, culturally relevant messaging and initiatives, are revolutionizing outreach to the Black American community and elevating the education and awareness of sexual health and wellness, and bringing greater awareness to the social justice issues disproportionately impacting the health and wellness of Black Americans.

August 2024 AHF Key Highlights Month Over Month

AHF Clients:

As of August 2024, and with the 7/30/24 Global Patient Report, AHF now has 2,121,986 clients in care.

This figure represents an overall global census INCREASE (up 53,695 AHF clients worldwide), month-to-month since the July 2024 Global Patient Report.

AHF Staff:

A net INCREASE of 65 AHF employees worldwide to 7,881 total AHF employees worldwide, including:

- An INCREASE of 7 U.S. staff
- An INCREASE of 23 employees in global staff numbers, and
- 1,969 other AHF-supported staff in global programs (bucket staff, casuals, etc.) up 35 staff.

This report also includes a breakout of the 1,541 clients now enrolled in our various Positive Healthcare (PHC & PHP) Medicare and Medicaid managed care programs in California.

US & Global Programs & Countries:

US—Two (2) new US AHF Healthcare Centers opened in August, 2024: One (1) in Ft. Myers, Florida, another in Austin, Texas, where one(1)AHF Pharmacy and one (1) Out of the Closet thrift store co-located at the same Austin site also opened. NO new domestic AHF Wellness Centers were added in August 2024.

GLOBAL—AAHF's Global program now operates 916 global AHF clinics, ADDING thirteen (13) new global health care centers. AHF also ADDED (5) new Global Wellness Centers in August 2024 under the new AHF Wellness Center Grant. Four (4) of these centers were the first AHF Wellness Centers in their respective countries: Ethiopia, Nigeria, Rwanda and Thailand.
